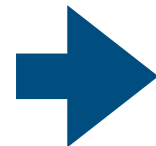




COVID-19 Documentation Mobile Web App

What is it?

- Mobile container for important **King County** documentation and training materials related to COVID-19
- Mobile container for **your** agency-specific documentation
- Contains both PDF documents and links to video (that play within the app)
- Items can be shared via text and email, as well as displayed independently on your mobile web browser (where they can be printed)
- Web app was designed for mobile devices, so you would always have easy access to the information, but can run in a desktop browser window.

Who made it? Who's it for?

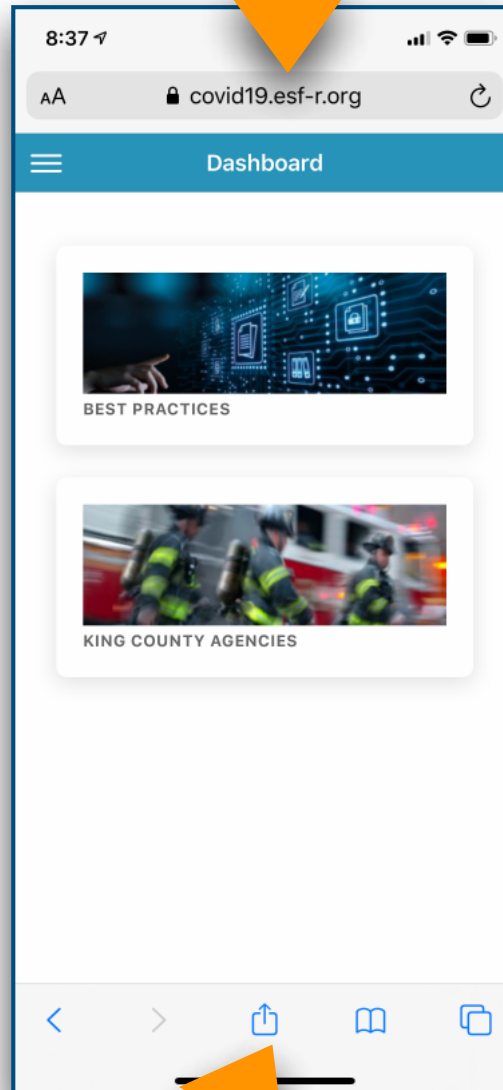
- Eastside Fire & Rescue developed the application

- 2 Click vertical ellipsis button (top-right-hand corner)



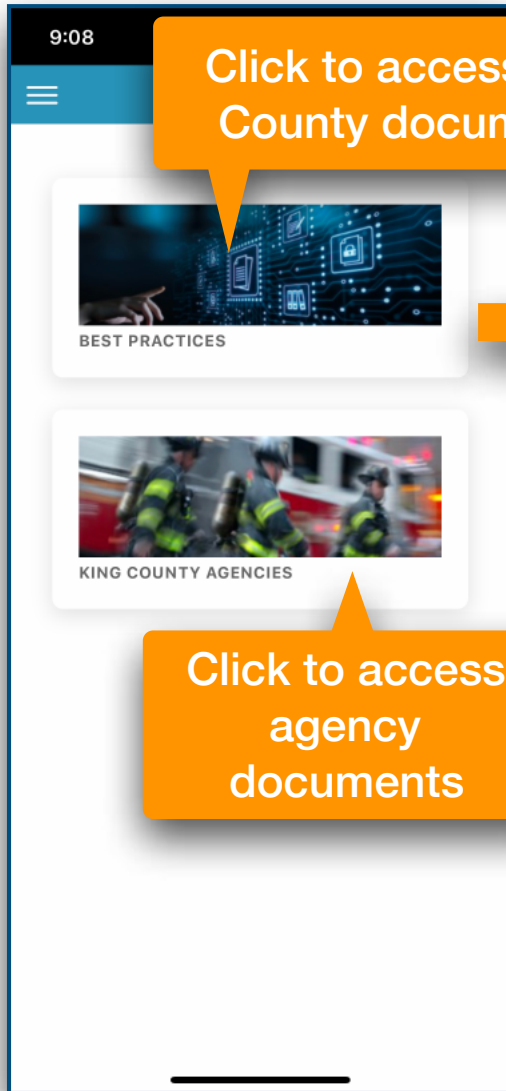
Start



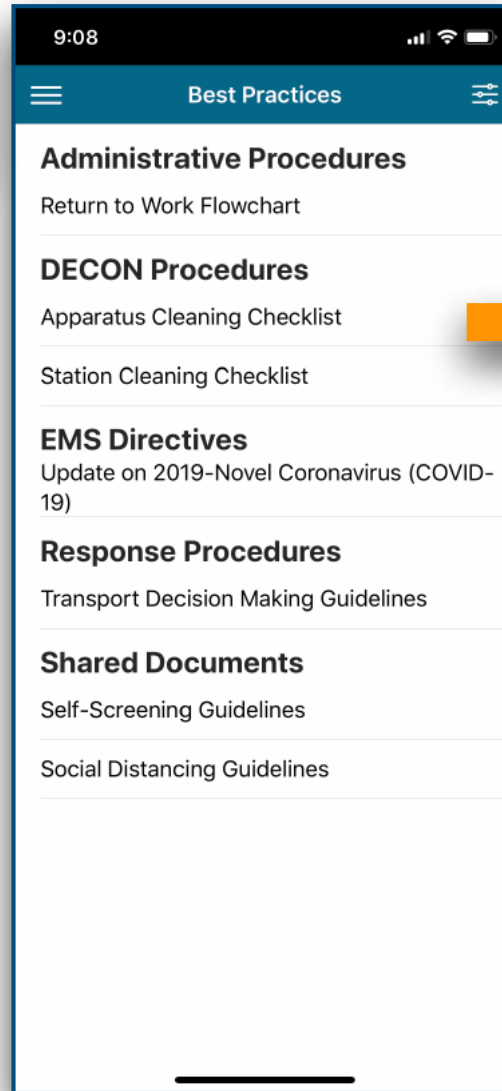
- **Find the icon on your phone**

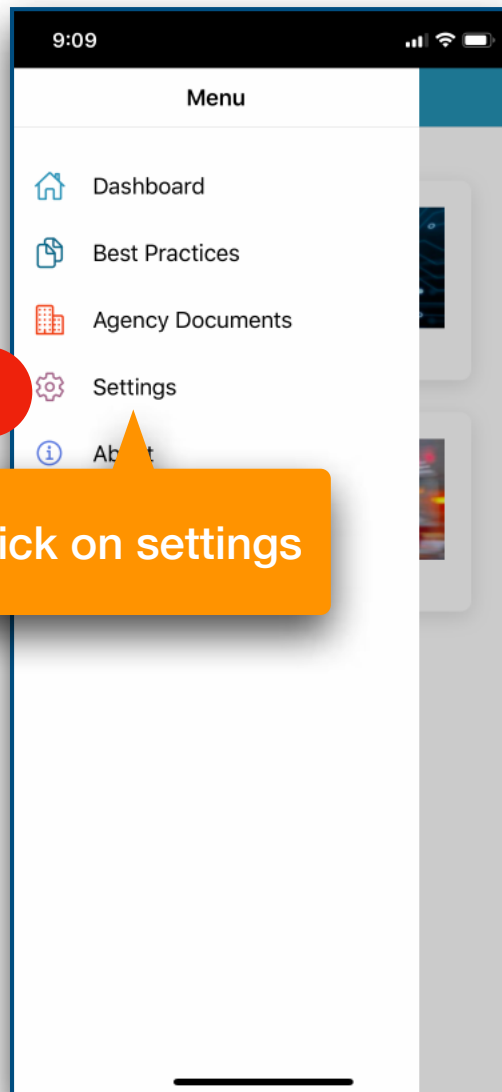

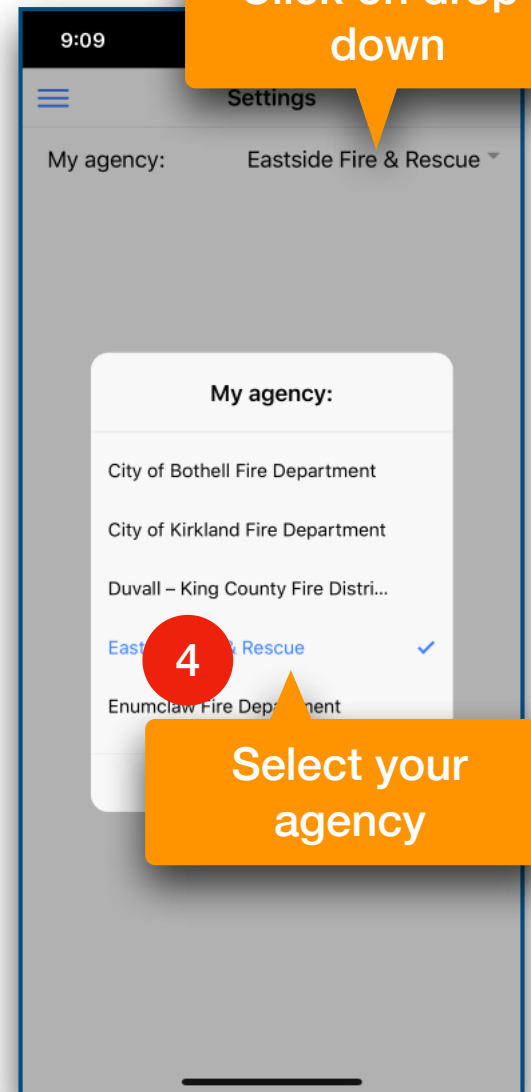
